

Introduction

Emergency care of children has emerged as an important subspecialty. About 20% of patients seen in the A&E department are of pediatric age group of which 58% are below five years.

The Bahrain Pediatric Association and the Medical Education & Training Office (Secondary Health Care), have recognized the importance of this field of medicine in identification and stabilization of emergency ill children.

The increased need for educating healthcare providers on the approach to critically ill child as well as identifying common emergent disorders of childhood has been identified and this symposium has been organized.

The symposium will provide an overview of common paediatric emergencies; their diagnosis and treatment; relying on interactive sessions. The basics of pediatric airway management and cardiopulmonary resuscitation will be emphasized by practical sessions.

Aim

The symposium is intended to allow participants to become familiar with the common emergent problems of childhood.

3. Improve quality of care given in pediatric emergency medicine

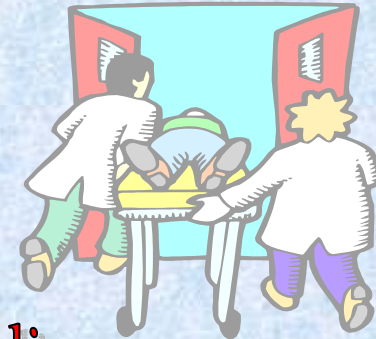
