Incidence of Appendicitis due to change of Dietary Habits in Bahrain

Core Data:

130 appendectomies

Age distribution of patients

10 years – 12 patients (9 M + 3 F)
11 years – 15 patients (10 M + 5 F)
12 years – 19 patients (12 M + 7 F)
15 years – 21 patients (15 M + 6 F)
17 years – 30 patients (18 M + 12 F)
19 years – 17 patients (10 M + 7 F)
20 years – 10 patients (7 M + 3 F)
22 years – 6 patients (4 M + 2 F)

80 patients consume Beef burger regularly
50 patients consume Beef burger occasionally

30 patients consume vegetables occasionally

20 patients from well to do families
89 patients from middle class families
21 patients from low income groups

THE EXERCISE

Write a short “original” paper on the incidence of appendicitis due to change of dietary habits in Bahrain using the above core data. The paper should include the following sections:

Abstract
Introduction
Methods
Results
Discussion
Conclusion
References

You must first “introduce” and formulate a scientific hypothetical hypothesis and use the supplied core data as “(Patients) Method” to either support or refute this hypothesis. Accordingly, you can design and calculate the “Results” as you may wish. Throughout the text the statements and interpretation of findings must then be “discussed” scientifically and “supported” by relevant observations of other scientists and this need to be “abstracted” to help readers and indexers.
