

Question and Answer

How does the contact testing process take place?



1

Active COVID-19 patients are asked about all individuals they have been in contact with, and a comprehensive list of all contacts is prepared

2

The identity of each contact is determined by tracing their locations and identifying the dates and locations of their interactions with active cases

3

Contacts of active cases are determined, and data on the Ministry of Health website is updated

4

Each contact is immediately contacted to schedule a COVID-19 testing appointment and is provided with the necessary instructions

5

In the event of a negative result, contacts of active cases will be required to begin home self-quarantine for a period of 14 days and each individual is obligated to download the 'BeAware Bahrain' application. Their medical results can be viewed via the application or via the Ministry of Health website

6

Contacts of active cases must book an Exit Test in order to complete their quarantine period (the appointment can be booked through the 'BeAware' application)

7

Each contact will be informed of the test results before completing their home quarantine period. They will also be provided with the necessary instructions according to the result of their Exit Test
