- Quarantine for non-vaccinated travellers arriving from all countries

# on all flights starting Monday, 24 May 2021

The suspension of entry for travellers arriving from red list countries, namely:













India

Pakistan Bangladesh Sri Lanka Nepal

Vietnam





Bahraini nationals and passengers holding a valid residency visa are exempted from the above restriction, but along with all non vaccinated travelers will have to:



### Quarantine for 10 days

at their own residence or at a government designated hotel licensed by the National Health Regulatory Authority




Present a negative test certificate with a QR code for a PCR test administered within 48 hours of their departure.



Passengers are required to undergo PCR on arrival and on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of their stay.







## Passengers arriving from the countries not included in the red list are exempted from:

# Quarantine and PCR tests





if they are vaccinated and hold a Bahrain issued vaccination certificate or a certificate issued by a country whose vaccination certificate is approved by authorities in Bahrain, or a certificate issued by a country that has reciprocal recognition agreement with the Kingdom of Bahrain.

# Quarantine

if they are vaccinated and hold vaccination certificates issued by:

the United States of America, the United Kingdom, a member state of the European Union, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, South Korea, Japan or Singapore.
