




Contact tracing of active COVID-19 cases







Tracing contacts



Who is a contact of an active COVID-19 case?



Those who were in direct contact with the active COVID-19 case for up to 15 minutes, at a distance of less than two meters, and without wearing a mask.



Anyone who had been in a closed environment with the active COVID-19 case without proper ventilation. (Note that a person is considered a contact in this case if they were in direct contact with

the active COVID-19 case for up to 15 minutes, even if they were wearing a mask).



Anyone who shares housing and facilities with the active COVID-19 case.

Whoever was in direct physical contact with the active COVID-19 case, such as through shaking hands, or having touched anything in the same place.






The specified time period for tracing contacts



Those in contact with the active COVID-19 case from the day of the positive test result and two days prior









The specified time period for tracing contacts



Those in contact with the active COVID-19 case from the day of the positive test result and two days prior to the appearance of symptoms









The precautionary quarantine for contacts of active COVID-19 cases

Contacts holding a green shield



Contacts who do not hold a green shield





Are not subject to a precautionary quarantine

Are required to quarantine for seven days

Anyone who experiences any COVID-19 symptoms (such as a high temperature, coughing, and shortness of breath) should get tested
